

Designed in 1929 by architect Robert Mallet-Stevens to serve as a primary residence, Villa Cavrois stands atop Beaumont hill in Croix like a modern-day château.

Built away from the pollution of the factories of Roubaix, it provided the Cavrois family with an extraordinary living environment, complete with 5 hectares of grounds, a swimming pool and a mirror of reflecting water. The rooms of the Villa Cavrois are infused with the full breadth of early-20th-century artistic influences thanks largely to the detail of its lines and the harmony of the materials used.

Major restoration work has revived the unique feel of each $% \left(1\right) =\left(1\right) \left(1\right)$

of its rooms, meaning that visitors now get to experience the Villa as it was in 1932 as they immerse themselves as never before in the aesthetic experimentations of the time!


